## CROCHET HOOK

1.75mm (no 15) (US 5 steel) crochet hook

## TENSION

Completed motif A measures 10 cm (4 in) in diameter using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook.

## CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

**3-picot cluster** = 4 ch, 1 ss into 4th ch from hook, (3 ch, 1 ss into same ch as previous ss) twice; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **dtr** = double treble; **htr** = half treble; **sp(s)** = space(s); **ss** = slip stitch; **tr** = treble.

MOTIF A (make 14 [16])

Using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook make 15 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.

**Round 1 (RS):** (4 ch, 1 dtr into ring, 4 ch, 1 ss into ring) 12 times.

**Round 2:** Ss along and into top of first dtr of previous round, 1 ch

(does NOT count as st), 1 dc into dtr at base of 1 ch, \*11 ch, miss (4 ch, 1 ss, 4 ch, 1 dtr, 4 ch, 1 ss and 4 ch), 1 dc into next dtr, rep from \* to end, replacing dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.

**Round 3:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), miss dc at base of 1 ch, \*1 dc into each of next 5 ch, 3 dc into next ch, 1 dc into each of next 5 ch, miss 1 dc, rep from \* to end, ss to first dc. 78 sts.

**Round 4:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 6 dc, (3 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of next 12 dc) 5 times, 3 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of last 6 dc, ss to first dc. 90 sts.

**Round 5:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 7 dc, (3 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of next 14 dc) 5 times, 3 dc into next dc, 1 dc into each of last 7 dc, ss to first dc. 102 sts.

**Round 6:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, \*6 ch, miss 7 dc, (1 dtr, 5 ch, 1 ss into 3rd ch from hook, 2 ch) 4 times into next dc, 1 dtr into same dc as used for last 4 dtr, 6 ch, miss 7 dc, 1 dc into each of next 2 dc, rep from \* to end, replacing 2nd dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

MOTIF B (make 12 [22])

Using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook make 6 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.

**Round 1 (RS):** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 12 dc into ring, ss to first dc.

**Round 2:** 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), 1 tr into dc at base of 3 ch, 2 tr into each of next 11 dc, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round. 24 sts.

**Round 3:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, 1 dc into each of next 23 dc, ss to first dc.

**Round 4:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, \*5 ch, miss 2 dc, 1 dc into next dc, rep from \* to end, replacing dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.

**Round 5:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, \*(1 htr, 3 tr, 3-picot cluster, 3 tr and 1 htr) into next ch sp, 1 dc into next dc, rep from \* to end, replacing dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.

**Round 6:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch, \*7 ch, miss (1 htr and 3 tr), 1 dc into centre loop of next 3-picot

cluster, 7 ch, miss (3 tr and 1 htr), 1 dc into next dc, rep from \* to end, replacing dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.

**Round 7:** Ss into first ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), \*8 dc into next ch sp, 3-picot cluster, miss 1 dc, 8 dc into next ch sp, miss 1 dc, rep from \* to end, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

MOTIF C (make 12 [24])

Using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook make 8 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc into ring, 3 ch, 1 dtr into ring, 3 ch) 8 times, ss to first dc.

**Round 2:** Ss along and into top of first dtr, \*12 ch, 1 tr into 9th ch from hook, 3 ch, miss (3 ch, 1 dc and 3 ch), 1 ss into next dtr, rep from \* to end, working ss at end of last rep into same dtr as last ss at beg of round.

**Round 3:** 1 ss into each of first 4 ch (last ch worked into in same ch as used for first tr of previous round), 3 ch (counts as 1 tr), \*(1 htr, 7 dc and 1 htr) into next ch sp, 1 tr into next tr, miss (3 ch, 1 ss and 3 ch)\*\*, 1 tr into next ch, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round.

**Round 4:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into "sp" created by tr at end of last round and 3 ch at beg of last round, \*3 ch, miss (1 tr, 1 htr and 1 dc), 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, miss 1 dc, (1 dc, 4 ch and 1 dc) into next dc, 3 ch, miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc, 3 ch, miss (1 dc, 1 htr and 1 tr)\*\*, 1 dc between tr just missed and next tr, rep from \* to end, ending last rep at \*\*, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

MOTIF D (make 38 [58])

Using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook make 8 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.

**Round 1:** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 16 dc into ring, ss to first dc.

**Round 2:** 5 ch (counts as 1 tr and 2 ch), miss dc at base of 5 ch and next dc, \*1 tr into next dc, 2 ch, miss 1 dc, rep from \* to end, ss to 3rd of 5 ch at beg of round.

**Round 3:** Ss into first ch sp, 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr, 1 htr and 1 dc) into each ch sp to end, ss to first dc.

Fasten off.

BACK and FRONT

Following appropriate diagram, draw out back and front outlines full size. Position motifs within these outlines as shown in diagram. Now join motifs together as follows: attach yarn to edge of one motif, work the required length of ch, then work a ss into the adjacent motif (to join them) and fasten off. Work these lengths of ch at random and of varying lengths until all motifs are joined together. Where some motifs meet, you may prefer to work a zigzag length of ch, rather than lots of short strips.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Position outlines so that shoulder edges match and join motifs along shoulder edges in same way as previous motifs were joined. Similarly, join side seams.

**Neck edging**

Using 1.75mm (US 5 steel) crochet hook, attach yarn along neck edge outline and work a length of ch around the neck outline, replacing some of the ch sts with dc, htr, tr or dtr where appropriate so that this line of sts forms a smooth neck outline, ending with ss to first ch.

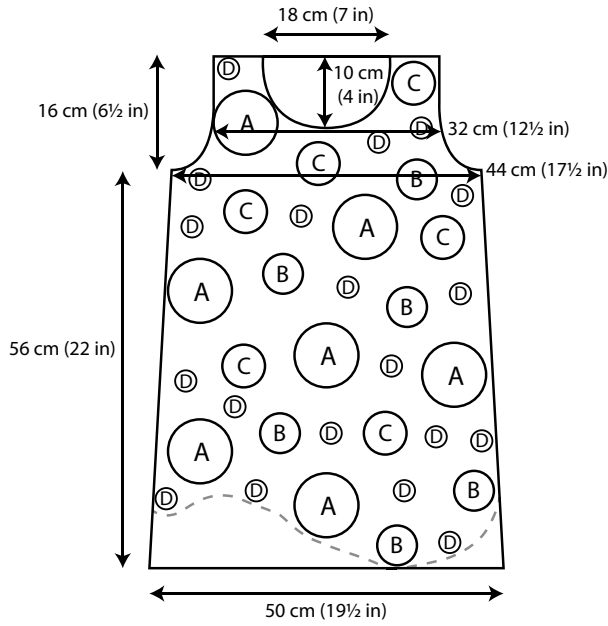
**Next round (RS):** 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each st to end, ss to first dc.

**Armhole edgings (both alike)**

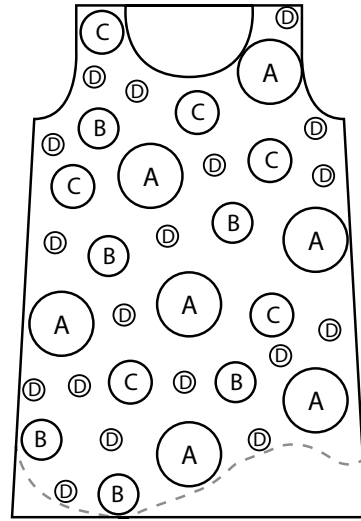
Work around armhole outline in same way as for neck edging.

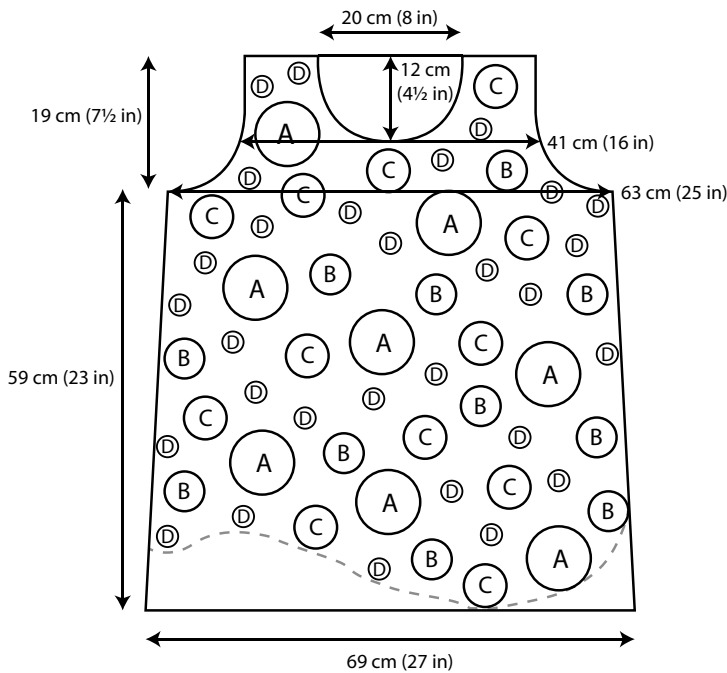
Size S-M Front Diagram



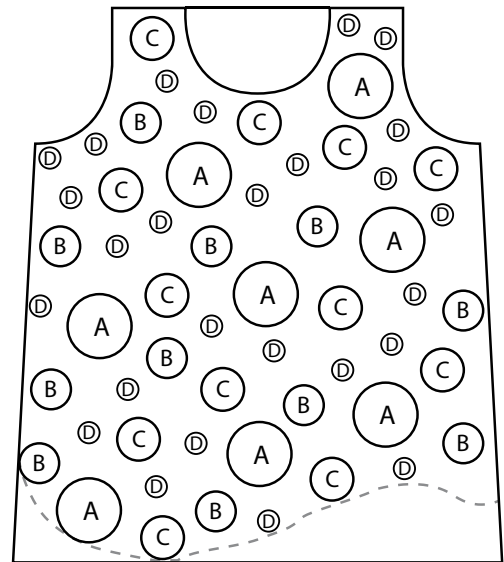
Size S-M Back Diagram
