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YARN

Rowan Summer Tweed and Kidsilk Haze

A	KSH Anthracite 639	1	x 25gm
B	KSH Trance 582	1	x 25gm
C	STw Harbour 549	2	x 50gm
D	KSH Heavenly 592	1	x 25gm
E	STw Toast 530	1	x 50gm
F	KSH Majestic 589	2	x 25gm
G	STw Reed 514	1	x 50gm
H	KSH Dewberry 600	1	x 25gm
I	STw Blueberry 525	1	x 50gm
K	STw Sweet Pea 543	1	x 50gm

NEEDLES

6mm (no 4) (US 10) circular needle, 120 cm long

TENSION

18 sts and 26 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 6 mm (US 10) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed wrap measures 150 cm (59 ins) long (excluding fringe) and 40 cm (15½ ins) wide.

Pattern note: Fringe is formed by knotting together ends of yarns used for stripes. When joining in and cutting off yarns, leave an end of approx 25 cm - this will form the fringe.

WRAP

Using 6mm (US 10) circular needle and yarn C cast on 270 sts. Work in g st for 2 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Joining in and cutting off colours as required (see pattern

note) and beg with a K row, now work in st st in stripes as follows:

Rows 1 and 2: Using yarn F.

Row 3: Using yarn B.

Row 4: Using yarn G.

Row 5: Using yarn B.

Row 6: Using yarn H.

Row 7: Using yarn F.

Row 8: Using yarn A.

Row 9: Using yarn I.

Row 10: Using yarn B.

Row 11: Using yarn A.

Row 12: Using yarn K.

Rows 13 and 14: Using yarn B.

Row 15: Using yarn D.

Row 16: Using yarn F.

Row 17: Using yarn G.

Row 18: Using yarn A.

Row 19: Using yarn F.

Row 20: Using yarn H.

Row 21: Using yarn C.

Row 22: Using yarn B.

Row 23: Using yarn H.

Row 24: Using yarn F.
